

Visitation Policy

As of 8/17/21

For the protection of Southcoast Health's patients, employees and providers, please adhere to the following:

VISITING HOURS — ONE visitor at a time*

Hospital: 10am – 8pm

Unvaccinated children under age 12 are not allowed to visit the hospital at this time

**Exceptions:*

- *End of life and/or patient on Comfort Measures Only*
- *If visitor is between ages 12-18, two visitors would be allowed since the minor would need to be accompanied by an adult*
- *Clinical team allows for more than one visitor for other unique circumstances*
- *Parents of pediatric patients are not considered to be visitors*

Emergency Department — ONE visitor

Visitor must remain with patient, NO visitor re-entry after exit

Surgical Patients and Same Day Surgery Center

ONE visitor will be allowed to visit and/or accompany a patient

Physician Offices, Imaging, Radiology, Laboratory Patient Service Center

ONE visitor will be allowed to visit and/or accompany a patient

NO visitors experiencing cough, shortness of breath, temperature over 100 degrees or other symptoms consistent with COVID-19 will be allowed

NO in-person seminars, classes, or gatherings
