## **Cardiac Surgery Pre-Operative Oral Care Instructions**

The following oral care instructions can significantly decrease the risk of respiratory infection after cardiac surgery.

## Beginning 2 days or 48 hours before your surgery:

- 1. Brush teeth and tongue for 1-2 minutes with a soft toothbrush and rinse your mouth with water as you normally would do. If you have dentures, brush and rinse them as well.
- 2. You will be given a prescription for Chlorehexidine Gluconate .12% (Peridex) mouth rinse by the NP / PA. Fill the dosage cup to the ½ fl. Ounce line and swish in your mouth undiluted for 30 seconds and then spit out.
- 3. Do not swallow this rinse. Do not eat, drink or smoke for 30 minutes after swishing.
- 4. Brush teeth, rinse and swish with Chlorhexidine Gluconate .12% (Preidex) twice a day (morning and night), and morning of surgery as well.
