Visitation Policy

For the protection of Southcoast Health's patients, employees and providers, please adhere to the following:

VISITING HOURS — ONE visitor at a time* Hospital: 10am – 8pm

Maternity: 11am – 2pm & 5pm – 8pm

Unvaccinated children under age 12 are not allowed to visit the hospital at this time. (See exceptions below)

*Exceptions:

- End of life and/or patient on Comfort Measures Only
- If visitor is between ages 12-18, two visitors would be allowed since the minor would need to be accompanied by an adult
- Siblings of newborns are allowed to visit their family. No Visitors are allowed on Labor and Delivery.
- Infant and pediatric patients' parents are not considered to be visitors
- Clinical team allows for more than one visitor for other unique circumstances
- + Emergency Department ONE visitor** Visitor must remain with patient, NO visitor re-entry after exit **At the discretion of the clinical team

+ Surgical Patients and Same Day Surgery Center + Physician Offices, Imaging, Radiology, Laboratory Patient Service Center ONE visitor will be allowed to visit and/or accompany a patient

NO visitors experiencing cough, shortness of breath, temperature over 100 degrees or other symptoms consistent with COVID-19 will be allowed

NO in-person seminars, classes, or gatherings
