Reminder on proper use of N95 respirator masks

Please note that ear loop clips, straps, rings or extensions, including buttons on headbands, **should NOT be used** with any fitted N95 respirator mask as they can impact and break the seal, placing the user at risk for exposure.

Clips available through Employee Health for use with loop masks to decrease ear irritation

To decrease irritation behind the ears from surgical-type ear loop masks, clips are available in Employee Health for use with all masks that do not require specific fittings and fit testing.

STATUS REPORT: COVID-19 cases

Currently, we have 117 patients who have tested positive for COVID-19 hospitalized across our system – with 18 positive cases in ICU. In addition, we currently have no PUI currently hospitalized across our system.
